We Welcome a New Habitat Family

Our beautiful two-story 2006 Habitat House at 520 Kenwood Avenue is complete. The September 16 Dedication ceremony drew around eighty volunteers and business donors—one of the largest crowds ever! If you have not had a chance to see the house, please drive by and view the excellent job our Catholic/Presbyterian family of volunteers did this year. Once more we have presented decent, affordable housing to a deserving family and a welcoming neighborhood.

Brittany Cottrell and her daughter, Da'Bria, were visibly overjoyed at the Dedication. She was so overwhelmed by the kindness of others that all she could say was “Thank You.” Brittany worked faithfully through the summer with our volunteers at the site. Though her “sweat equity” hours were mostly complete before the build started, she wanted to be an integral part of her house build. Her family supported her as the house was built and participated in its dedication. Her grandfather Deacon Fred Cottrell led the

Litany for Habitat at the end of the ceremony. Her mother, Barbara, beamed as many other family members arrived to support Brittany.

The move from Brittany’s old residence was made the very afternoon of the Dedication. She was ready to begin her new life! By Sunday afternoon, she was watering the sod and plantings and she had placed decorative solar lights along her front walk. Her excitement was evident. We wish her luck, love and good times ahead with her neighbors.

The impetus for our builds comes from many places in scripture. One of the most straightforward passages is in Micah, Chapter Six. It is, of course, the imperative: “What does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God.”

In the effort to do justice, we work year after year, planning and building for another family’s opportunity to own their own home with associated homeowner responsibilities. Each family knows that this is not simple charity, but a

concerted effort to make them part of the community. One of our earlier Habitat T-shirts presented it elegantly: “The poor do not need charity as much as they need capital, and not caseworkers as much as they need co-workers.”

Coalition on Homelessness and Housing in Ohio

The Coalition on Homelessness and Housing in Ohio (COHHIO) is an organization that works on behalf of homeless and low-income citizens. As Catch the Building Spirit, they believe that everyone deserves a decent home.

Their belief is that a house is the basis for a home. It's the structure inside which our lives unfold; where we nurture our children, face our challenges and celebrate our milestones. For a house to become a home it must be safe, decent, affordable—and available. In Ohio, more affordable housing is badly needed. Last year, approximately 150,000 Ohioans were homeless. Nearly one in four Ohioans could not afford the fair-market rent of a two-bedroom unit; and foreclosures continue to crush the dream of home ownership in Ohio at a rate that is three times higher than the national average.

At COHHIO we believe that everybody should have a home, so we advocate on behalf of those who

do not. COHHIO supports a range of housing assistance services in Ohio, including homeless prevention, emergency shelters, transitional housing and permanent affordable housing with linkages to supportive services as needed. Helping hundreds of housing organizations and homeless service providers pursue their missions, COHHIO provides public policy advocacy, training and technical assistance, research and public education.

Since 1994, COHHIO has worked on behalf of every Ohioan in need of a house, in hopes that someday these simple physical structures can become lasting homes filled with life's possibilities.

Below are some of COHHIO's accomplishments, which have benefited not only homeless and low-income citizens but all Ohioans.

- COHHIO played a pivotal role in winning \$50 million in annual funding for the Ohio Housing

Trust Fund in 2003. Future efforts will focus on removing the fund's cap to help meet the growing need for affordable housing.

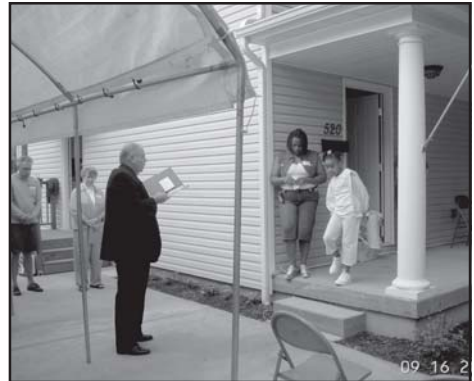
- COHHIO's six-year effort to protect homeowners against predatory lending concluded with the passage of the Homebuyers' Protection Act on June 19. Through the advocacy of our members, legislative commitment, media attention and public education, the Ohio General Assembly produced a bill that protects consumers and will make lenders honest and accountable.
- COHHIO aggressively opposed the TEL/TABOR amendment—a rigid budget formula that threatens to undermine funding for essential public services—that was supposed to be on the November '06 ballot. Through COHHIO's efforts, public pressure and the statewide Coalition for Ohio's Future, TEL/TABOR never made it on the ballot, which was a win for Ohio.

Interesting Facts

Have you ever wondered what it takes to build a two-story Habitat house? Well, here are some statistics. The house on Kenwood Avenue took 4,354 hours to build. It took 167 volunteers to do the work. There were volunteers from 32 churches and organizations.

In addition, 38 in-kind donors

provided materials and/or services. Our donors provided the funds to buy the materials needed to build the house. We can't forget all the other volunteers that work behind the scenes to get everything ready for the build.

What is so special about each house is that most of the work is done by volunteers. They take great

pride in their work as you can see from the houses that they have built. We can't thank all our volunteers enough for the time they put into planning and building this house for the Cottrell family. I hope they will join us again as we plan for another year.
